- Winner 'Outstanding Library Team' 2022 Times Higher Education Awards




Need for maximising open access and research management



- Differing open access requirements for researchers: which journals can they
  publish in? Are journals compliant with funder requirements? Are funds available?
- Labour intensive administration. Delays in invoice payments delays publication.
- What are Read and Publish agreements? And how do we evaluate them?
- Complex process for researchers uploading research into Pure.
- Manual data entry.
- Metadata missing follow up often required with researchers.

Automated consolidation of the article data for all agreements

No duplicates (using DOI), match with agreement, journal and institution

Data import via Excel or automated via OA Switchboard or publisher being on ChronosHub



- The integration between ChronosHub and Pure is to be finalised
- Data on persons, affiliations, grants and funders in Pure will be used in ChronosHub
- This enables a direct matching using the same PIDs in Pure and ChronosHub and a fully automated data transfer
- New research outputs (meta-data and fulltexts) will be added through the re-configured widget and transferred from ChronosHub to Pure once published to minimize back and forth
